Family Camp

The purpose of family camp is to bring the family together with God as their focus. There are age appropriate ministry times for everyone involved, as well as group and family fun times and activities. There are usually 20 or so families at each of these camps.

AIM program (1st half)

A.I.M (Assistants in Mission) is designed for high school students who have already committed themselves to the road of discipleship with Jesus and desire to gain deeper insight into what it means to be an ambassador of the Kingdom of God. AlMers have the opportunity to be a part of a small community of other students and embark on a two week intensive discipleship course, committed to in-depth Bible study, work projects, intentional worship, special events, and fellowship with other students in a similar place within their faith. AlM usually has 10 - 15 participants.

Middle School Camp

Campers entering into grades 6th - 8th come together for an amazing week of fun, friendship, and learning more about following Jesus Christ in their lives. Various church youth groups and individuals gather in a camp size of 30 -100 people.

High School Camp

Two separate weeks of campers (entering freshmen through graduating seniors) come to Calvin Crest for a time of discipleship, rest, relationship building, and fun activities. Various church youth groups and individuals come together for a camp size of 100 -150 people

Sherwood Forest

This camp is a magical place for children entering grades 3rd through 5th grade! Campers engage in age appropriate bible studies, experiential hands-on learning, imaginative activities and fun, all within the framework of the Robin Hood/Sherwood Forest story. Camp size range from 50 - 100 children.

Outdoor Adventure Camp (formerly Outpost)

A special week for Middle School aged campers who enjoy the outdoors; hiking, biking, tent camping and meals around the campfire. This week usually has a more intimate number of participants (around 12), and staff members must be in good physical shape to keep us with all the activity.

Cross Culture Camp

This year we have the privilege to host 30 middle schoolers from the country of China to come learn about outdoor education and participate in an American camp. These campers will have their own program during the day, and mingle with our other campers during free time. Staff must be friendly, outgoing, and good with other cultures.

Week in the Forest

Our campers this week are teens and adults that are affected by disabilities (around 20-40 people total). Our program engages campers with the love of God, the glory of God's creation, and the joy of being together in community with people who love and respect each other.
