

ADDITIONAL PACKAGES



MAKE A SPLASH

Spend 5 hours @ the Pool | Flume | Lake: \$200 | family

Weather permitting, families can split five hours between the pool, the flume, or kayaks and paddle-boats on the lake. A certified lifeguard will accompany each family to the flume or pool. Flume participants must be 40" or taller.



TAKE A HIKE

Take a guided hike with a Calvin Crest staff: \$200-\$250 | family

Choose from a 3-4 hour guided hike to the stunning top of Fresno Dome, the 2700-year-old Bull Buck Tree in Nelder Grove, or the swimming pools of Grey's Mountain; OR a 5-6 hour guided hike to the pristine alpine Iron Lakes.

SWING & CLIMB

Challenge yourself for 2 Hours @ the Giant Swing & Rock Wall: \$150 | family

Families can split their time between the 40-foot-high giant swing and the six routes of varying difficulty on the rock wall. Harnesses and helmets are sanitized between guests and events are facilitated by trained staff.

Swing participants must be fourth grade or older, at least 48" tall, and less than 250 pounds.

Rock Wall participants must be 40" or taller and less than 250 pounds.



CRAFT IT UP

Get creative during a 2 hour craft workshop: \$35 | person or \$60 | family

Join Katiepillar to create stunning works of art in the craft condo.

All supplies are included in the price and sanitized between guests.



PICK & PRESS

Enjoy a Calvin Crest fall apple pressing tradition: \$50 | family

Families can use Calvin Crest's apple pickers to collect a basket of apples and learn from Calvin Crest staff how to operate our antique cider press (generally 1 hour). Each family will leave with a jar full of homemade apple cider (in season, while quantities last).



FIRE & ICE

Families can help themselves to unlimited firewood and ice: \$25 | family

Please note that Westview and Mountain View cabins sleep 8 people and can accommodate two additional cots for a maximum of ten people. Larger groups will need to rent an additional cabin.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

If I want to camp in Sherwood, do I need to bring a tent or will mattresses be available in the huts?

You are welcome to bring tents or stay in the huts. Mattresses will be available in a central location where you can retrieve and carry them to your hut and sanitize before and after using.

May I bring my RV or tent trailer?

Yes. However, we do NOT have any hook-ups for electricity, water, or sewer at this time. We will have designated parking spaces in Mountain View and Sherwood based on size or length of trailer.

May I request a particular Mountain View/Westview cabin or Sherwood hamlet?

Yes, availability is on a first-come, first-serve basis. We also caution that if you request Reddingham, please be aware that others may want to climb on the Reddingham Stump or cut through this area to access the trailhead to George's Falls. We will also urge others to be considerate to those camping in that hamlet.

Will bathrooms be available in Sherwood Forest?

Yes, we will have *select* bathrooms open in Sherwood, and we strive to provide separate bathrooms for each family; therefore some hamlets require walking a distance to the bathroom.

What can I expect to see when I arrive at Calvin Crest?

Since the start of Covid-19, Calvin Crest has operated with a lean staff, proving it challenging to keep up with the grounds. In addition, our forest stewardship program has taken advantage of this time without campers to complete some much needed removal of dead and dying trees around camp, which has caused quite a bit of debris. While we have been slowly cleaning this up, you may find that camp is in rougher shape than other years due to this critical work. Ultimately, Calvin Crest will be safer as a result.

Is there an opportunity to do volunteer projects while we are at Calvin Crest?

Yes. Yes. And yes. We would love for you to help with clean-up, painting, or other projects we can customize just for you. Just let us know upon registration, and we can arrange to work with you.

Will any food service be available at Calvin Crest?

Unfortunately, we are not able to provide food service at this time. However, you are welcome to bring your food in coolers, and for a small fee, we would be happy to provide ice as often as needed. Small kitchenettes (with sink, microwave, and full refrigerators) are available in Mountain View lounge and Cedar Lodge. Cedar Lodge guest rooms are equipped with mini fridges and microwaves. In Mountain View, we have a charcoal grill available for anyone to use, and you bring your own charcoal. We also have tabletop propane grills available to rent for \$10 day or \$25 for your stay. Flat-top grills are available in Sherwood that fit over each burn pit, and we will provide a Sherwood grill pack at check-in, which will include a brush, scraper, tongs, and large spatula. Our water is great potable water, so you can fill up water bottles at camp.

Will trash collection be available?

Yes, you can dump trash in our designated dumpsters at camp. We require those staying in Sherwood to keep all garbage in your car at night (if not taken to a dumpster) to avoid any unwanted visitors. Open food containers in the cabin areas may also invite critters.

Will any indoor common spaces be available to us?

Yes, the Dining Hall, Cedar Lodge Fireside room, and Mountain View Lounge will be open and available for families to work, study, play games, do puzzles, or hang out. Both Cedar Lodge and Mountain View Lounge have a kitchenette with a fridge and microwave. We ask families to practice social distancing and to wear masks as appropriate, and we will provide sanitization supplies to wipe down space before and after usage. Also, laundry facilities will be available for \$5 per load. Please bring your own detergent.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Will the pool or lake be open to use this fall?

Yes, the pool and lake will be open as long as the weather permits. If families choose not to purchase a package, reservations may be made for the pool or flume for \$50 per hour for family groups of up to ten people. Multiple families may share the pool but will be charged \$50 per hour to cover additional lifeguards for larger groups. Please indicate at registration the day and time of your pool or flume request to allow us time to secure a certified lifeguard. We will gladly discount the pool fee to half if you bring a lifeguard with you; proof of certification will be required at check-in. Paddle-boats and kayaks do not require a lifeguard and are available for \$25 an hour. This fee helps to cover sanitization and any repairs.

Will any other activities be available at Calvin Crest?

The giant swing and rock wall are available in a package or a la carte. We have adult bicycles (for participants 4'11" and taller) available for rent and can be checked-out for the duration of your stay. Due to minimal staffing, any other requests for particular activities will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

Can I bring my dog?

We love dogs! We invite guests with dogs to stay in Sherwood and Westview, and we have set aside a limited number of Mountain View cabins and Cedar Lodge rooms that will be first come - first served for those with a pet. There will be a \$25 cleaning fee for those in Mountain View and Cedar Lodge. We do ask that dogs are kept on leash at all times around other families, messes are cleaned up, and dogs are not a nuisance to other campers (barking, running loose, etc). **Out of consideration for other campers, we will reinforce these guidelines.** There is dog boarding available in Oakhurst, if needed.

Is there anything else I can not bring with me to camp?

Yes, we're so glad you asked. We don't like to focus on the negative, but you should not bring guns, alcohol, glass bottles, fireworks, dirt bikes/ATVs (unless using off-camp). Due to the extreme fire danger in our area, smoking is only allowed in designated areas in the parking lot.

What do I need to know about fire safety or evacuation procedures in case of a fire?

Upon check-in, we will review several fire safety guidelines with your party. We will provide fire safety equipment including a shovel, fire extinguisher, and hose. We will also review evacuation procedures, and we will ask you to sign out on a centrally located clipboard if you choose to leave camp during your stay so we know your whereabouts in the event of an evacuation.

Do I need to bring my own firewood?

You may bring your own firewood or choose to purchase a crate of firewood for \$5 or unlimited firewood and ice for \$25. You are also welcome to clean up camp by collecting dead wood and burning it.

Is there a limit to when we can come or how long we can stay?

Nope. Just let us know your plans upon registration.

Will we be able to reach a staff person in case of an emergency?

We will have a centrally located radio in both Sherwood Forest and Mountain View lounge in the event you need to reach a staff person in an emergency. Staff can generally be reached at the office Monday through Friday from 9 am - 4 pm, and on radios Saturday from 9-10 am and Sunday from 8-9 am.

How do I register?

You may register by calling our office at 559.772.4040 or you may register online. You will need to sign a liability release form upon registering.
