SUMMER 2021 PRICING

Sherwood Forest Hamlet: \$40 | night (up to 10 people, shared bathhouse*)

Westview: \$80 | night (up to 8 people | shared bathhouse)

Mountain View Cabins: \$120 | night (up to 8 people, private bath)

Cedar Lodge: \$160 | night (1-5 people, private bath)

*\$10 for each additional person in Sherwood hamlets

Rates are per night per room/cabin with a two night minimum. Bed and bath linens are provided in Cedar Lodge. Guests must provide bed and bath linens for all other lodging areas.

RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES

Must be reserved in advance and subject to staff availability

Paddle Boats & Kayaks: \$25 | hour (at your own risk)

Mountain Bike Rental: \$20 | bike for entire stay

Giant Swing: \$100 | hour*

Guided Hike: \$100-\$250 | group, depending on destination

*4th grade or older, at least 48" tall, and less than 250 pounds

EXTRAS

Ice: \$5 | bag, cash only


Firewood: \$5 | bundle, cash only

Laundry Room: \$5 | load (not including detergent)

Linens \$10 | linen pack (cabins only)

Tabletop Propane Grill: \$10 | day or \$25 | stay

Propane \$5 | add'l canister



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

If I want to camp in Sherwood, do I need to bring a tent or will mattresses be available in the huts?

You are welcome to bring tents or stay in the huts. Mattresses will be available in a central location where you can retrieve and carry them to your hut and sanitize before and after using.

May I bring my RV or tent trailer?

Yes. However, we do NOT have any hook-ups for electricity, water, or sewer at this time. We will have designated parking spaces in Mountain View and Sherwood based on size or length of trailer.

May I request a particular Mountain View/Westview cabin or Sherwood hamlet?

Yes, availability is on a first-come, first-serve basis. We also caution that if you request Reddingham, please be aware that others may want to climb on the Reddingham Stump or cut through this area to access the trailhead to George's Falls. We will also urge others to be considerate to those camping in that hamlet.

Will bathrooms be available in Sherwood Forest?

Yes, we will have *select* bathrooms open in Sherwood, and we strive to provide separate bathrooms for each family; therefore some hamlets require walking a distance to the bathroom.

What can I expect to see when I arrive at Calvin Crest?

Recently, we experienced a significant Mono Wind event that brought down hundreds of trees and destroyed some of our buildings. Days later, we received seven feet of snow, which delayed our clean-up efforts. While we have been working on cleaning up the trees and debris, you may find that camp is in rougher shape than other years. You may also see campers at Calvin Crest, as we are running a limited number of program camps this summer.

Is there an opportunity to do volunteer projects while we are at Calvin Crest?

Yes. Yes. And yes. We would love for you to help with clean-up, painting, or other projects we can customize just for you. Just let us know upon registration, and we can arrange to work with you.

Will any food service be available at Calvin Crest?

Unfortunately, we are not able to provide food service at this time. However, you are welcome to bring your food in coolers, and for a small fee, we would be happy to provide ice as often as needed. A small kitchenette (with sink, microwave, and full refrigerator) is available in Cedar Lodge. Cedar Lodge guest rooms are equipped with mini fridges and microwaves. We also have tabletop propane grills with propane available to rent for \$10 day or \$25 for your stay. (Additional propane canisters are \$5 each.) Flat-top grills are available in Sherwood that fit over each burn pit, and we will provide a Sherwood grill pack at check-in, which will include a brush, scraper, tongs, and large spatula. Our water is great potable water, so you can fill up water bottles at camp.

Will trash collection be available?

Yes, you can dump trash in our designated dumpsters at camp. We require those staying in Sherwood to keep all garbage in your car at night (if not taken to a dumpster) to avoid any unwanted visitors. Open food containers in the cabin areas may also invite critters.

Will any indoor common spaces be available to us?

Yes, the Dining Hall and Cedar Lodge Fireside room may be open and available for families to play games, do puzzles, or hang out depending on whether they are being used for Program Camps. You may inquire at registration, and we can tell you if these spaces will be available during your visit. Cedar Lodge has a kitchenette with a fridge and microwave. We ask families to practice social distancing and to wear masks as appropriate, and we will provide sanitization supplies to wipe down space before and after usage. Also, laundry facilities will be available for \$5 per load. Please bring your own detergent.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Will the pool or lake be open to use?

Yes, the pool and lake will be open each day at no additional cost, and hours will be posted. If not being used for a program camp, the pool may be reserved for private use at \$50 per hour for family groups of up to ten people. Please indicate at registration the day and time of your private pool request to allow us time to secure a certified lifeguard. We will gladly discount the pool fee to half if you bring a lifeguard with you; proof of certification will be required at check-in. Paddle-boats and kayaks do not require a lifeguard and are available for \$25 an hour. This fee helps to cover sanitization and any repairs.

Will any other activities be available at Calvin Crest?

Yes, the giant swing, boats, and guided hikes are all available at an additional fee. Adult bicycles (for participants 4'11" and taller) are available for rent and can be checked-out for the duration of your stay. Due to minimal staffing, any other requests for particular activities will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

Can I bring my dog?

We love dogs! However, because we are running program camps this summer with campers onsite, we are not allowing dogs. There is dog boarding available in Oakhurst, if needed.

Is there anything else I can not bring with me to camp?

Yes, we're so glad you asked. We don't like to focus on the negative, but you should not bring guns, alcohol, glass bottles, fireworks, dirt bikes/ATVs (unless using off-camp). Due to the extreme fire danger in our area, smoking is only allowed in designated areas in the parking lot.

What do I need to know about fire safety or evacuation procedures in case of a fire?

Upon check-in, we will review several fire safety guidelines with your party. We will provide fire safety equipment including a shovel, fire extinguisher, and hose. We will also review evacuation procedures, and we will ask you to sign out on a centrally located clipboard if you choose to leave camp during your stay so we know your whereabouts in the event of an evacuation.

Do I need to bring my own firewood?

You may bring your own firewood if you are local or choose to purchase a crate of firewood for \$5. You are also welcome to clean up camp by collecting dead wood and burning it. There is plenty of wood around!

Is there a limit to when we can come or how long we can stay?

Nope. Just let us know your plans upon registration. There is, however, a two-night minimum stay.

Will we be able to reach a staff person in case of an emergency?

We will have a centrally located radio in both Sherwood Forest and Cedar Lodge kitchenette in the event you need to reach a staff person in an emergency. Staff can generally be reached at the office Monday through Friday from 9 am - 4 pm, and on radios Saturday from 9-10 am and Sunday from 8-9 am.

How do I register?

You may register by calling our office at 559.772.4040 or you may register online. You will need to sign a liability release form and agree to our Covid-19 guidelines upon registering. We will also screen you for Covid-19 upon arrival, including taking your temperature.
